# Job

Job 1:1-2:6; 42

Job had it all, or so it seemed; a loving family, crops, cattle, and more. Then, in one horrible day, it was all taken away. But instead of cursing God, Job responds, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD" (Job 1:21).

As we read further in the Book of Job, we learn that Job's troubles are the result of specific testing by Satan. When Job sins by questioning God's care for him, God still forgives Job, eventually restoring Job's fortunes.

## Family Faith Talk

"Thy will be done . . ." God's will is done in our lives when He breaks the plans of the devil and all things that want to destroy our faith in Jesus. Terrible things happened to Job, but God kept him strong in his faith. Talk about some of the things that seem terrible to your child and how God promises to be with us, no matter what. He works through His Word to keep us strong in faith. Have family members share their favorite Bible passage and tell what it means to them. Challenge one another to memorize the passages shared.
